VERONICA TAYLOR NATURAL DISASTERS RECOVERY

On Friday afternoon 4 March RCBS enjoyed the privilege of a presentation by Veronica Taylor entitled "A Different Approach to Disasters." She observed that "Service Above Self" is a major driver of disaster response, and offered heartfelt thanks to Rotarians for their contributions in support of disaster response and relief.

Veronica is a former Rotarian who misses her former Rotary family in Lagrange, Georgia USA. She was working in Thailand for EGAT when the 26 December 2004 Tsunami struck and devastated many communities including Phuket. This event changed both her life and her career path. Six months after the tsunami, Veronica moved back to the USA and joined Habitat for Humanity.

On 29 August 2005, Hurricane Katrina struck New Orleans, LA USA. In her management role with Habitat for Humanity, Veronica was responsible for managing \$32 million USD of donations to rebuild homes for the victims of Hurricane Katrina.

Veronica observed that over the past 10 years, 700,000 people have died from natural disasters. She noted that deaths resulting from natural disasters have decreased significantly; humanity is getting much better at saving lives. However, the cost of disasters has increased exponentially, from \$5 billion USD in 1970

to \$75 billion USD in recent years. Economic losses associated with disasters have increased by 15 times while corresponding GDP has only increased by 5 times since 1970.

Additionally, due to increased urbanization and migration to urban centers, the number of people impacted by natural disasters has increased significantly. Up to 1.7 billion people have been impacted in the past 10 years. 57% of global fatalities occurred in the Asia Pacific region, and 87.6% of people affected by disasters live in the Asia Pacific region.

Veronica discussed the evolution of modern disaster management. The Disaster Continuum

consists of four (4) stages: Response, Recovery, Mitigation, and Preparedness. The new disaster management paradigm is moving the focus from Response and Recovery to Mitigation and Preparedness.

Disaster Response remains an important function, but Disaster Risk Reduction and Resilience is currently judged to be more important and is therefore the new focus. Risk Reduction primarily involves proactive efforts to mitigate the risk of future disaster events. Resilience is a reflection of how quickly a community can recover from a disaster.

Building Disaster Resilience is very important to preserving the region's economic prospects. This requires a shift in the allocation of resources. Donors can achieve the biggest bang for their donations by targeting their donations to decrease the physical and social vulnerabilities in communities. Don't wait until there is a disaster to act. Invest today through your donations to decrease today's vulnerabilities, to achieve increased resilience to future disasters.
