ANUTIN CHARNVIRAKUL DELIVERING VITAL ORGANS

On Friday afternoon 22 April RCBS was honored to host a presentation by Anutin Charnvirakul. Anutin is the leader of the Bhumjaithai Party, former Chairman of Sino Thai Engineering, and is viewed as a strong future Prime Minister candidate. He has a BS in Industrial Engineering from Hofstra University in the USA, an Honorary doctorate degree in Civil Engineering from Ramkamhaeng University, and a Mini MBA from Thammasat University.

Anutin noted that his father was a Rotarian, and he spoke of the importance of helping others.

In addition to his business and political responsibilities, Anutin enjoys flying his own airplanes. He has combined his love of flying and his desire to help others in need by volunteering to transport sick patients and transplant organs.

In the past year, Anutin has flown 10 flying missions in support of heart transplants. He works closely with the Organ Transplant Division of the Red Cross. The Red Cross maintains a transplant registry that is very carefully managed to ensure fairness, matching available organs with sick patients. They use a system of random matching to assign donated organs to recipients. Anutin explained that the Red Cross system ensures that they have no way of knowing the identity of the recipients, ensuring that there is no chance for corruption or favoritism.

Time is very critical for the success of transplant organs. A human heart must be transplanted within 6 hours. Air transport is therefore required to ensure that organs can be collected and delivered most quickly. Pilots must adhere to strict rules concerning consumption



of alcohol prior to flying. Since Anutin must be on call 24x7 to be available immediately whenever an organ donor flight is required, he no longer drinks alcohol.

Anutin explained that donated organs must come from healthy donors who have been the victims of sudden catastrophe. He said that "the donors don't know that in 2 hours they will be dead." One organ donor can provide up to five organs, a heart, two kidneys, lungs, and a liver. One organ donor flight can therefore save up to five lives. The first Thai heart transplant patient received his heart in 1987 and is still alive; many recipients enjoy long lives after receiving their life saving transplant.

Anutin described his role of delivering vital human organs as "a job of pride, not a job of duty." He downplayed his personal role in the process. He described himself as being the postman, and he gave much credit to the doctors and medical professionals who obtain, remove, prepare, and transplant the organs to patients who are otherwise terminally ill. He also gave great credit to the Thai Red Cross who diligently manages the process.


