## CLEAN DRINKING WATER SYSTEMS

PP John gave a very detailed and passionate overview of the Clean Drinking Water for Schools project, mingled with comments and side bars that added to his talk.

In following his plan, here are the main points he discussed.

### Rationale

The schools we support are outside major towns and have no potable water supply. The raw water usually comes from a well. In the rainy season it is ok. In the eight-month dry season, it is awful.

Bad water makes kids ill. They miss school, drop behind and with their families not having a culture of fostering education, they expect to fail so they let the kids drop out.

With no education they become poor farmers like their parents. The cycle of poverty continues.

### Technology

We propose a "cookie cutter" solution. We have a single-design 3000lpd RO system. We do not adapt it to fit different schools, rather we choose schools for which our solution is appropriate. The advantage of that approach are low transaction costs, rapid installation and a high number of installations per year.

We install a reverse osmosis water filtration system which can deliver clean drinking water for 400 children 24 hours a day for up to 10 years. The costs with construction of a shelter, raw water and electricity connections, storage tank, delivery, installation and a maintenance fund of 25,000 Baht comes to between 120 to 150,000 Baht

Excess water is made available to the village families who save on buying bottled water in the dry season

### Strategy

Since the beginning, over 20 years ago we have installed 596 CDWS throughout Thailand. In 2013 we changed our Strategy to emphasize Sustainability.

We now concentrate our on-going review only on systems that are less than ten years old and located in District 3360. This reduces our focus area to 145 existing systems.

### Visits to Existing Systems

Since 2015, we have documented 147 visits to 86 (out of 145) schools. We repeat-visit when repairs are needed as we must follow up.

Our Database records all dealings with each school.

The CDWS in 72 of the 86 schools visited are running well. Three are currently under repair and 11 have been abandoned. No system under six years old has been abandoned.

### New Systems

We target to install about ten systems per year and to document a working-life per system of 5-10 years.

In practice, this last Rotary Year we installed 15 new systems and relocated a further seven. That was too much work for the current committee.

In RY 2018-19, we already have an oral commitment for ten systems from C&C Travel of Denmark.



### Challenges

The main challenge is a lack of RCBS Manpower. Our Water Team is small and even older than our club average and includes Rotarians Marco, Michael G-H, Ola, Michael B, and John Q.

Our District 3360 Partners (CP Supaporn and PP Supapol) are retiring, thus putting even more work on to us as they now go around their region finding schools, talking to people and completing a great many of the initial steps on our behalf.

This last point about the Supa-team is worrying. At present we target to visit each school before awarding a CDWS to check if all is ok, at the time of Installation of the machinery, at Inauguration and then approximately every two years thereafter.

With (say) 140 systems in operation and ten new per year that would imply about 100 visits per year without including repairs and rejections.

The bottom-line is that unless more people can begin to help, our Clean Drinking Water Systems initiative is going to slow down, if not fade into history.

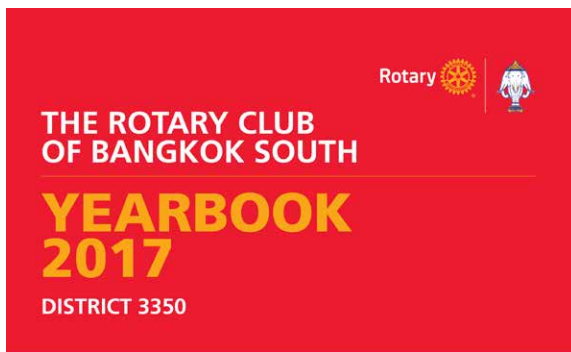
